He pioneered the Global Trade Facilitation Summit "GTFS" which is now a priority technical trade finance event for trade finance professionals across the globe. The 3rd edition of GTFS was held 1-2nd May, 2024 in Dubai. UAE.

Vincent also holds the positions of the Associate Director of the Institute of International Banking Law and Practice (IIBLP).
